Potential Myrtle Rust hosts

- *The following plants are banned and are **not** to be brought into the RTBG under any circumstances.*

All members of the Myrtaceae plant family are potential hosts of myrtle rust, including

- Gum trees (*Eucalyptus*)
- Red Dragon, Black Stallion, Rainbow's End, Krinkly (*Lophomyrtus*)
- Bottlebrush (*Callistemon, Melaleuca*)
- Tea tree (*Leptospermum*)
- Lilly pilly (*Syzygium, Acmena, Waterhousea*)
- Paperbark (*Melaleuca*)
- Myrtle (*Backhousia*)
- Chilean guava (*Myrtus* or *Ugni*)
- Midyim (*Austromyrtus*)
- Rose apple (*Syzygium*)
- Brush box (*Lophostemon*)
- New Zealand Christmas bush (*Metrosideros*)
