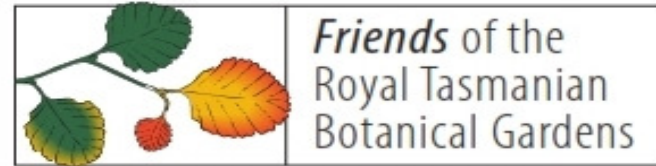


Friends of the Royal Tasmanian Botanical Gardens
